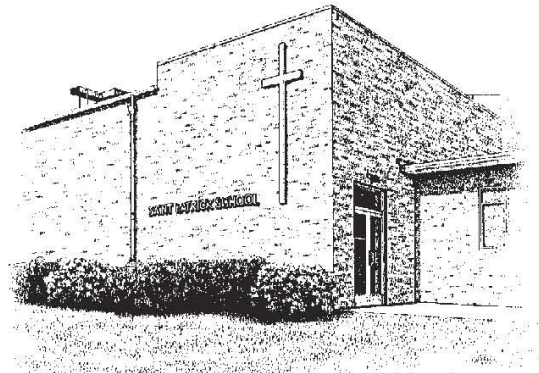

**DECEMBER 30, 2018**

**First Reading: Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14**

Sirach emphasizes the importance of honoring one's parents. He explains that spiritual riches will come to those who are kind to their mother and father.

**Second Reading: Colossians 3:12-21**

Paul advises us to treat each other with kindness and mercy and to forgive as God forgives us. His words remind families to always love and respect one another and let Christ's peace reign in their hearts and in their homes.

**Gospel: Luke 2:41-52**

When Jesus was twelve years old, the Holy Family traveled to Jerusalem to celebrate the feast. Jesus did not return with the company. Instead, he stayed in Jerusalem, sitting among the teachers while amazing them with his understanding and questions. When found by his concerned parents, Jesus reminded them that he must be in the house of his Father. Returning together, Mary kept these things in her heart.

All necessary paperwork is available online with instructions and must be returned to the Parish Office **BEFORE** you attend the Baptism Class. **SAINT OF THE WEEK**

**Mary, Mother of God (January 1<sup>st</sup>)**

Mary's divine motherhood broadens the Christmas spotlight. Mary has an important role to play in the Incarnation of the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity. She consents to God's invitation conveyed by the angel (Luke 1:26-38). Elizabeth proclaims: "Most blessed are you among women and blessed is the *fruit of your womb*. And how does this happen to me, that *the mother of my Lord* should come to me?" (Luke 1:42-43, emphasis added). Mary's role as mother of God places her in a unique position in God's redemptive plan.

Without naming Mary, Paul asserts that "God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law" (Galatians 4:4). Paul's further statement that "God sent the spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying out 'Abba, Father!'" helps us realize that Mary is mother to all the brothers and sisters of Jesus.

Some theologians also insist that Mary's motherhood of Jesus is an important element in God's creative plan. God's "first" thought in creating was Jesus. Jesus, the incarnate Word, is the one who could give God perfect love and worship on behalf of all creation. As Jesus was "first" in God's mind, Mary was "second" insofar as she was chosen from all eternity to be his mother.

The precise title "Mother of God" goes back at least to the third or fourth century. In the Greek form *Theotokos* (God-bearer), it became the touchstone of the Church's teaching about the Incarnation. The Council of Ephesus in 431 insisted that the holy Fathers were right in calling the holy virgin *Theotokos*. At the end of this particular session, crowds of people marched through the street shouting: "Praised be the *Theotokos*!" The tradition reaches to our own day. In its chapter on Mary's role in the Church, Vatican II's *Dogmatic Constitution on the Church* calls Mary "Mother of God" 12 times.

*Comment:* Other themes come together at today's celebration. It is the Octave of Christmas: Our remembrance of Mary's divine motherhood injects a further note of Christmas joy. It is a day of prayer for world peace: Mary is the mother of the Prince of Peace. It is the first day of a new year: Mary continues to bring new life to her children—who are also God's children.

**ST. PATRICK'S SCHOOL APPLICATION  
PROCESS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2019-20**

**Procedure:** Appointments must be made by telephone, call 718-979-8815 for an interview for the week of **January 29<sup>th</sup>**.

**Requirements:** PreK-3 (three years by 12/31/18); UPK-4 (four years by 12/31/18); Kindergarten (five years by 12/31/18); and First Grade (six years by 12/31/18). Child must be present.

**Certificates for ALL Grades:** (a) Birth; (b) Baptismal (if Catholic or Christian); and (c) Immunization-complete records, including name of doctor. No child can be accepted without proper immunization. **Additional Requirements for Grades 1+:** (a) Standardized tests results (b) Report Cards; and (c) Work Samples. All certificates must be submitted at appointment date.

**Registration Fee:** \$75.00 for 1 child; \$100 for two or more

**Tuition:** Only those active parishioners who present their envelope number at registration, who participate in the life of the parish and support the parish, will be given a parishioner's tuition rate.
