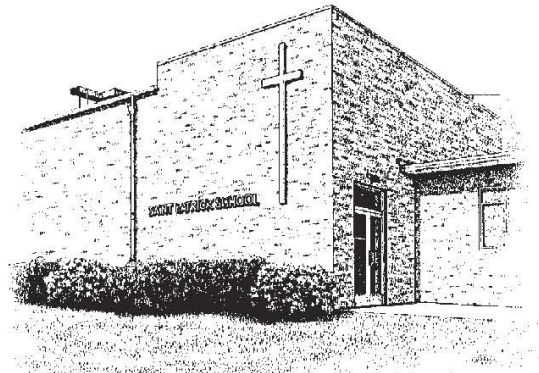

**First Reading: Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7**

Isaiah tells of the Lord's Servant, who will be inconspicuous, but will not rest until justice is established. The Lord then tells his servant that he was formed to be "a light for the nations."

**Second Reading: Acts 10:34-38**

Peter speaks to a group of pagans for the first time. He explains to them that any person who follows God's will is acceptable to God, regardless of nationality.

**Gospel: Luke 3:15-16, 21-22**

John the Baptist had claimed one would come far more powerful than himself, one who would baptize with the Holy Spirit rather than water. When Jesus came to John and was baptized, the Spirit descended on him and a voice said, "You are my beloved Son. On you my favor rests."

## REQUIREMENTS FOR BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered in the Church approximately every third Sunday at 2:15pm **OR** any Sunday during Mass. Once you have chosen a date and contacted the Parish Office, parents are **REQUIRED** to attend a Baptism Class in the Church held the first Monday every other month at 7:30pm. All necessary paperwork is available online with instructions and must be returned to the Parish Office **BEFORE** you attend the Baptism Class. The next **Baptism Class** is **March 4<sup>th</sup>** and upcoming **Ceremonies** are **Feb. 17<sup>th</sup> – Mar. 17<sup>th</sup> – Apr. 28<sup>th</sup> – May 19<sup>th</sup> – June 16<sup>th</sup> – July 21<sup>st</sup> – Aug. 18<sup>th</sup>**

## REQUIREMENTS FOR MARRIAGE

## SAINT OF THE WEEK

### Baptism of the Lord

Jesus' Baptism was similar to an inauguration. One day Jesus was standing in the crowd listening to John the Baptist. John always challenged his listeners to turn their backs on their sinful way of life and return to God. A sign that a person really wanted to live according to God's way was his or her public baptism, by John. When a person stood beside John in the water, everyone in the crowd expected that person to change for the better. After all the people that had come forward that day to be baptized, Jesus came forward. This was confusing to John the Baptist. He knew that Jesus did not need to change the way He lived. But the Gospel records show that when Jesus was baptized, a very important thing happened. Some signs showed that the Father and the Spirit were in intimate connection with Jesus. Jesus was anointed for His mission just like Isaiah had written: "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me... for Yahweh has anointed Me." Isaiah 61:1.

He has sent me to bring healing to the captives, good news to the poor, to the blind new sight, to set the downtrodden free, to proclaim a year of favor. Luke 4.

As baptized members of the Christian Community, we share in the mission of Jesus as members of The Church. We celebrate our unity with Christ and one another in the mission of The Church.

## ST. PATRICK'S SCHOOL APPLICATION PROCESS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2019-20

**Procedure:** Appointments must be made by telephone, call 718-979-8815 for an interview for the week of **January 29<sup>th</sup>**.

**Requirements:** PreK-3 (three years by 12/31/19); UPK-4 (four years by 12/31/19); Kindergarten (five years by 12/31/19); and First Grade (six years by 12/31/19). Child must be present.

**Certificates for ALL Grades:** (a) Birth; (b) Baptismal (if Catholic or Christian); and (c) Immunization-complete records, including name of doctor. No child can be accepted without proper immunization.

**Additional Requirements for Grades 1+:** (a) Standardized tests results (b) Report Cards; and (c) Work Samples. All certificates must be submitted at appointment date.

**Registration Fee:** \$75.00 for 1 child; \$100 for two or more

**Tuition:** Only those active parishioners who present their envelope number at registration, who participate in the life of the parish and support the parish, will be given a parishioner's tuition rate.
