NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Wisdom 18:6-9 On the long-awaited Passover night, God's children offered the paschal sacrifice.

Psalm 33 "Blessed the people the Lord has chosen to be His own."

Hebrews 11:1-2, 8-19 or 11:1-2, 8-12 By faith we join our ancestors in faith, as together in hope we journey toward our homeland.

Luke 12:32-48 or 12:35-40 The Son of Man will come at an unexpected hour.

Jesus wants to give us every chance to be ready for the return of the Lord. In the First Reading, we hear how our ancestors in faith prepared themselves for the night of the Passover. In the Second Reading, Saint Paul recalls how Abraham's faith made him ready to do God's will. So for us, Jesus' warning must not go unheeded. As we hear God's holy word proclaimed today, let us listen for a word that will help us to be ready for the Lord's coming.
