Today's readings address sickness and death. The First Reading speaks of death entering the world at the hand of the devil. The Gospel features a dying girl and an ill woman. But sickness and death do not have the last word. Not with God, for God made us that we may have life. Both the girl and the woman are cured. Thus, we can sing, as we do in the Psalm, "I will praise You, Lord, for You have rescued me."
