FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Ezekiel 2:2-5 They are a rebellious house but shall know that a prophet has been among them.

Psalms 123 "Our eyes are fixed on the Lord, pleading for His mercy."

2 Corinthians 12:7-10 I will boast in my weaknesses in order that the power of Christ may dwell in me.

Mark 6:1-6 A prophet is not without honor except in his native place.

Both Jesus and Ezekiel have a tough time preaching today. Jesus was dismissed because the people could not accept that this seemingly ordinary neighbor could teach them about God. Ezekiel had to preach to a people who had rebelled against God and were "obstinate of heart." Perhaps Saint Paul's insight is most helpful here: it is when God's grace allows me to overcome my own weakness that Christ's power is most truly revealed. May we have the humility to allow God's grace to strengthen us.
