## SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**Jeremiah 23:1-6** I will gather the remnant of my flock and appoint shepherds for them.

**Psalms 23** "The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want."

**Ephesians 2:13-18** Christ is our peace who made both one.

**Mark 6:30-34** They were like sheep without a shepherd.

Our readings today reveal and confirm God's desire to shepherd us: to care for, protect, and comfort us as shepherds tend their sheep. In the First Reading, God promises to provide shepherds for the people, particularly a descendant of David who will rule wisely and justly. In the Gospel, Jesus, Son of David, is moved with pity when people flock to Him, comparing them to sheep without a shepherd. With these passages in mind, we are able to sing in the psalm, "The Lord is my shepherd, there is nothing I shall want."

*The recipe for the chicken legs and thighs is as follows: Wash and clean chicken, season, place chicken in large tray, add ½ cup water. Bake at 375 degrees skin side down for 45 minutes, turn chicken over, season and bake skin side up for an additional 45 minutes. When the chicken is done sprinkle with paprika.*

*Please drain all juices and transport the chicken in Ziploc bags.*

The chicken is needed for this **Thursday, July 26<sup>th</sup>**. You may drop off at the chapel entrance 7:30-9:50 or the side parking lot at 9:45 am.
