**John 6:1-15** He distributed as much as they wanted to those who were reclining.

From now until the end of August, the Gospel will be a selection from a single chapter of John—the chapter in which Jesus reveals Himself as the Bread of Life, the one whose Body and Blood can bring eternal life. This chapter begins with Jesus feeding thousands by multiplying the loaves and fish, but we begin today with Elisha, a "man of God," who feeds a hundred people with twenty small loaves. Listening to the readings today, note all the acts of generosity.
