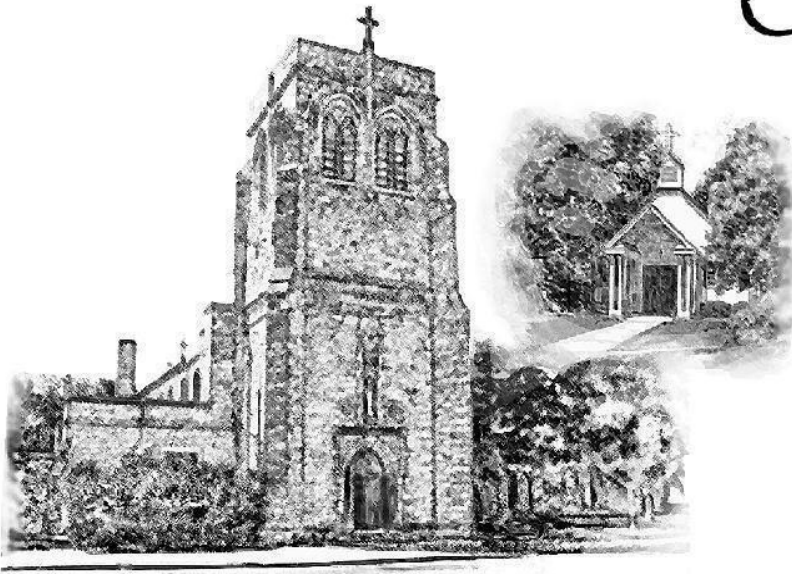

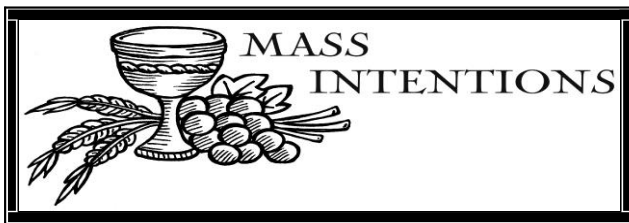

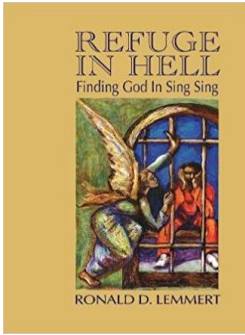

Imagine a parish where the entire congregation consists of murderers, thieves, rapists, child molesters and drug dealers. That was my congregation at Sing Sing Prison. It was quite a challenge helping them to discover that God could still love them in spite of all that they had done and that God was eager to help them rebuild their broken lives. The challenge was even greater within a very dysfunctional and corrupt prison system.

I wrote a book about this, **REFUGE IN HELL: Finding God in Sing Sing**, which was just published by Orbis Press at Maryknoll. I will be speaking about the book at a book signing in the 3rd Floor meeting room of the school on Sunday, September 30 at 7 PM. Copies of the book will be available for purchase for \$22.
