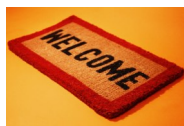

PAPAL PROCESSION TICKET GIVEAWAY

Residents of New York state may enter a ticket giveaway contest to receive two tickets for the Central Park Papal Procession to see Pope Francis on Friday, Sept. 25. Space is limited and ticket recipients will be selected at random.

Applications can be made from 12:01 am Thursday, Sept. 3, until 11:59 pm, Monday, Sept. 7, at the website of the City of New York, www.nyc.gov.

The procession will take place along the West Drive from 81st. Street to 59th Street-Columbus Circle. Guests must enter at their assigned gate, which will be listed on the ticket, beginning at noon. All ticket holders must be at their assigned gate no later than 3:30pm. Guests without tickets will not be permitted.

Spiritual Corner

Habemus Papam! These are the first words spoken to announce that the College of Cardinals have elected a new Holy Father. The words are Latin for "We have a pope!" As we prepare to welcome Pope Francis to the United States, the next few weeks give us the opportunity to reflect upon the gift of the Holy Father and to be grateful for instituting the office of the papacy.

The authority of the Holy Father has its origins in the entrustment of the faithful to St. Peter, who was the first pope. The first indication of Peter's place is after Peter has declared that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of the living God. Jesus responded, "Blessed are you Simon son of Jonah for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly father. And so I say to you, you are Peter and upon this rock I will build my Church and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. Peter's declaration of faith in Jesus as the promised Messiah led to our Lord's declaration that Peter would be the rock upon which the Church is founded and that hell itself would not prevail against the Church. Peter was a fisherman from Bethsaida who was with Jesus from the beginning of his public ministry. When we read the Gospels, so often Peter is the one who speaks or acts and then needs to be corrected by Jesus. For example, immediately after declaring Peter as the rock, Peter encouraged Jesus not to journey to Jerusalem and endure the Passion. Jesus rebuked Peter. The glory of St. Peter is that he knew and trusted that he could always return to Jesus for reconciliation.

The understanding of St. Peter's role as chief shepherd of the church comes from the encounter of St. Peter and the Resurrected Jesus. In order to erase Peter's three denials of our Lord on Holy Thursday, Jesus asks Peter three times whether St. Peter loves him. Peter affirms his love for our Lord. Jesus commands Peter to "tend my lambs", "tend my sheep" and "feed my sheep." Peter is to act as a shepherd to the church whilst never forgetting that he is to serve as a steward for the Lord's people.

The Acts of the Apostles inform us of St. Peter's early missionary efforts to the Jews and Gentiles. Ultimately, Peter would travel to Rome and give his life as a martyr to the faith. He asked to be crucified upside down because he did not feel worthy to die in the same way as Christ. The Church recalls the gift of the papacy on February 22, which is the feast of the Chair of St. Peter.

As we prepare to welcome Pope Francis, we must pray for the Holy Father as he comes to the United States and leads the Synod on the Family in Philadelphia.
