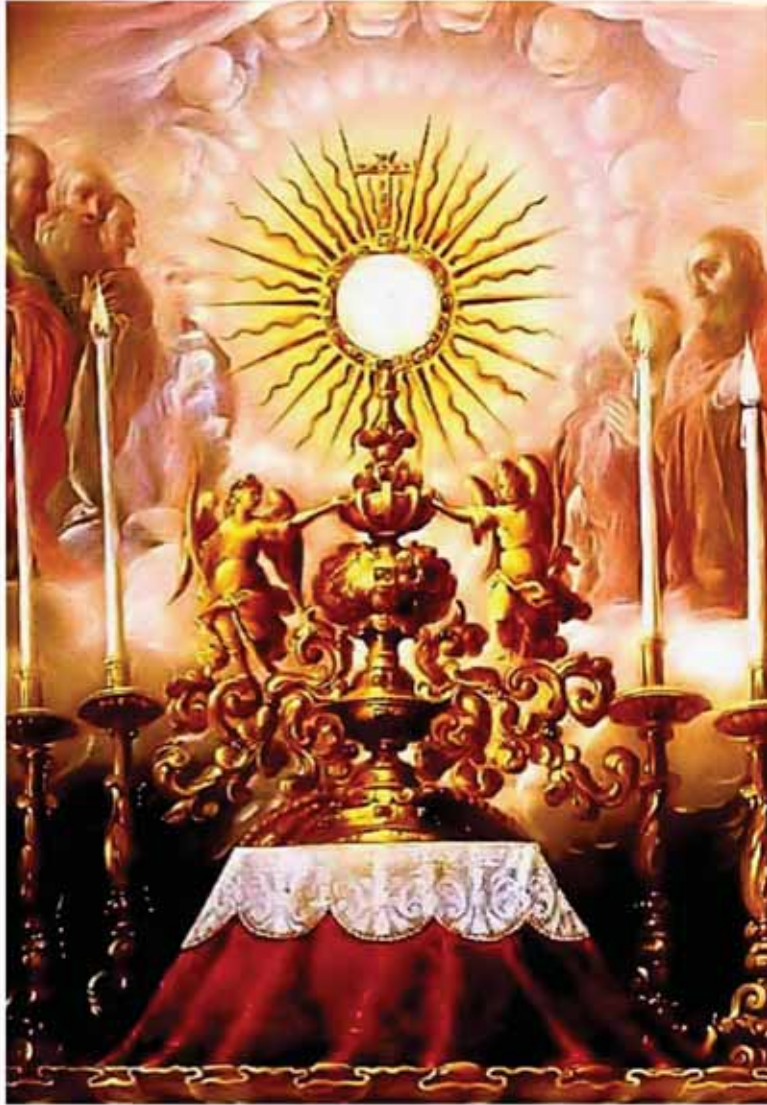

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: I Kings 19:4-8

Queen Jezebel had vowed to kill Elijah, who went into the desert and prayed for death. Instead he went to sleep and was awakened by an angel, who told him to eat the food God had given him. He ate and went back to sleep, but God's angel again woke him and told him to eat. Strengthened by the food, he got up and walked forty days and nights to the mountain of God.

Second Reading: Ephesians 4:30—5:2

Paul appeals to the Ephesians to get rid of bitterness, anger, and malice. Instead they must be kind, compassionate, and forgiving just as God has been. We must be imitators of Christ, and love one another as he has loved us.

Gospel: John 6:41-51

The Jews were not convinced that Jesus was the bread that came down from heaven. But he again explains that he is the bread of life. He tells them that anyone who believes and eats this bread shall live forever. He explains that the bread he will give is his flesh, for the life of the world.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

“Elijah prayed for death, saying: This is enough, O Lord. Take my life, for I am no better than my fathers. He lay down and fell asleep under the broom tree, but then an angel touched him and ordered him to get up and eat...for the angel of the Lord came back a second time, touched him and ordered ‘Get up and eat, else the journey will be too long for you.’ He got up, ate and drank...he walked forty days and nights to the mountain of God, Horeb.”

We return to Capernaum and find Jesus telling us ‘I AM the bread of life.’ It is in the Eucharist we find Jesus present to accompany us on our journey. Elijah was awakened twice and was ordered to brace himself for the journey. Jesus is the bread of life for us. We often overlook how great, how important, how necessary is this gift for our spiritual survival.

How many people in the world die each day of starvation? Too many, and we are called to assist them. How many people in the church take the gift of the Eucharist for granted? We speak of a priest shortage, while we should focus on the lack of appreciation for the gift of the Eucharist. Where in our world are people deprived of what is so essential, yet we sometimes take the priesthood, the mass and Eucharist for granted.

If Jesus is the bread of life, I need to go to Him with renewed fervor and gratitude. ‘Get up and eat, else the journey will be too long for you.’

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura: 1 Reyes 19:4-8

La reina Jezebel había jurado matar a Elías, quien fué al desierto y pidió morir. En vez, se durmió. Un ángel lo despertó y le dijo que comiera la comida que Dios le había dado. Comió y se volvió a dormir, pero el ángel de Dios lo volvió a despertar y le dijo que comiera. Fortalecido por la comida, se levantó y caminó cuarenta días y noches a las montañas de Dios.

Segunda Lectura: Efesios 4:30—5:2

Pablo pide a los efesios deshacerse de la amargura, enojo y malicia. En vez deben ser amables, compasivos, y perdonar como Dios lo ha hecho. Debemos imitar a Cristo y amarnos los unos a los otros como El nos ha amado.

Evangelio: San Juan 6:41-51

Los judíos no estaban convencidos de que Jesús era el pan que bajó del cielo. Pero El explica de nuevo que El es el pan de vida. Les dice que aquel que cree y come de su pan vivirá para siempre. Explica que el pan que dará es su cuerpo, para la vida del mundo.

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

“Elías deseó la muerte y dijo: ‘¡Basta ya, Señor! ¡Toma mi vida, porque no soy mejor que mis padres!’ Se acostó y se durmió bajo una retama, pero un ángel le tocó y le dijo: ‘Levántate y come.’ Miró y vio a su cabecera una torta cocida sobre piedras calientes y un jarro de agua. Comió y bebió y se volvió a acostar. Volvió por segunda vez el ángel del Señor, le tocó y le dijo: ‘Levántate y come, porque el camino es demasiado largo para ti.’ Se levantó, comió y bebió, y con la fuerza de aquella comida caminó cuarenta días y cuarenta noches hasta el monte de Dios, el Horeb.”

Retornamos a Capernaúm y encontramos a Jesús diciéndonos ‘Yo soy el pan de vida’. Es en la Eucaristía que encontramos a Jesús presente para acompañarnos en nuestra jornada. Jesús es el pan de vida para nosotros. A menudo no ponemos atención a lo grandioso, importante y necesario que este don es para nuestra sobrevivencia espiritual.

Hay tantas personas en el mundo que se mueren de hambre. Estamos llamados a ayudarles. Hay tantas personas en la iglesia que toman el don de la Eucaristía por dado. Hablamos de una escasez de sacerdotes, cuando deberíamos de enfocarnos en la falta de aprecio por el don de la Eucaristía. En un mundo en donde la gente carece de lo esencial, nosotros no valoramos el sacerdocio, la misa y la Eucaristía como deberíamos.

Si Jesús es el pan de vida, necesito acercarme a El con renovado fervor y gratitud. ‘Levántate y come, porque el camino es demasiado largo para ti.’

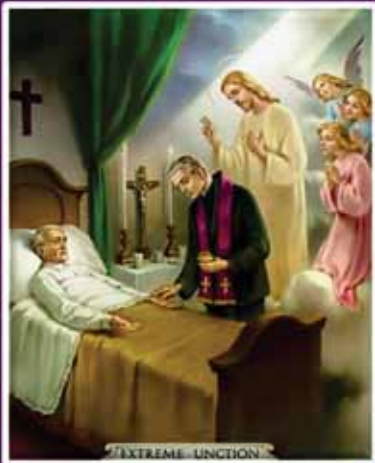

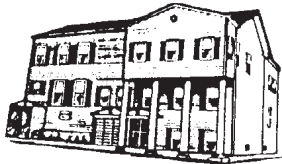
