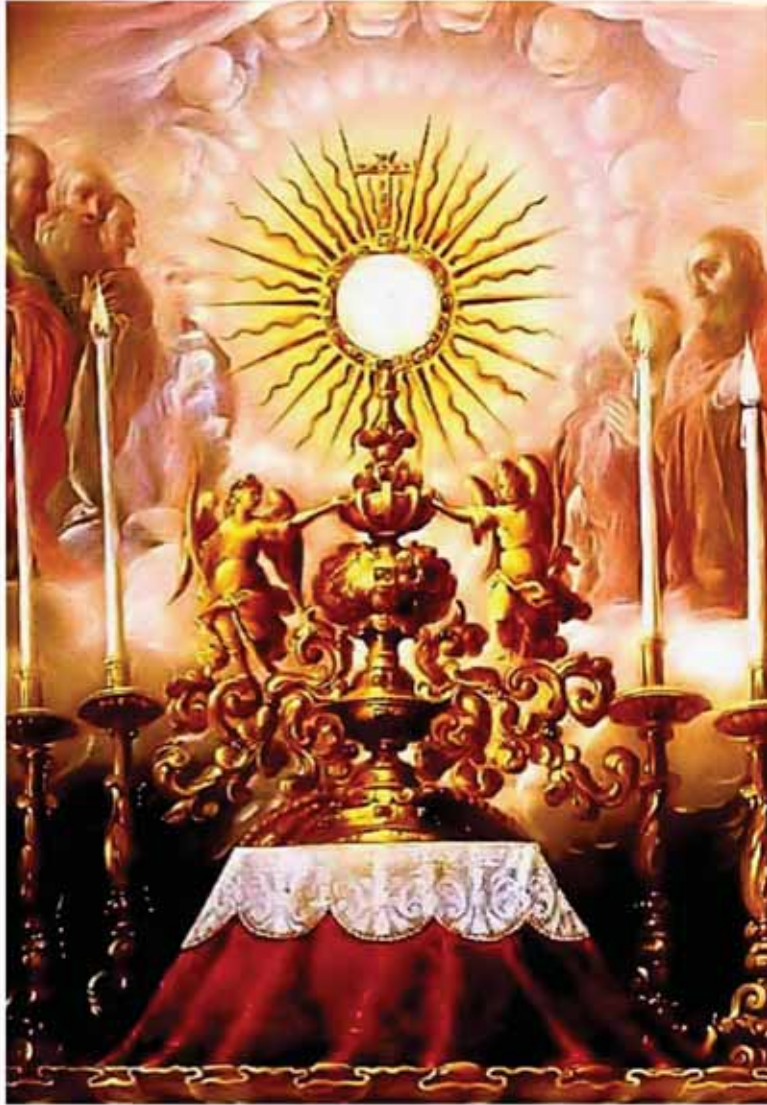

and snares of the devil.

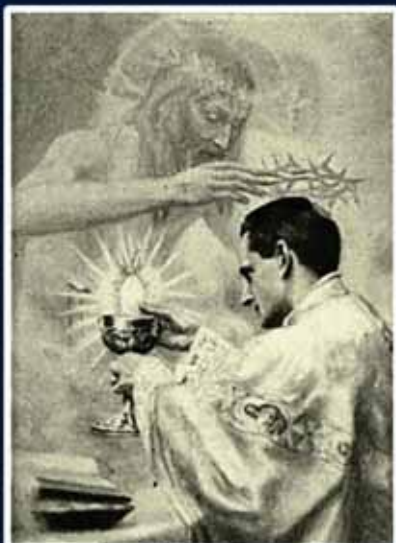
May God rebuke him we humbly pray;

### TODAY'S READINGS

#### **First Reading: Joshua 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b**

Joshua gathered all the tribes of Israel and told them if it did not please them to serve God, then they must decide who they would serve. The people claimed that God had brought them out of slavery and protected them on their journey. Therefore, they would serve, the Lord their God, and no one else.

#### **Second Reading: Ephesians 5:21-32 or 5:2a, 25-32**

Husbands and wives should love one another as Christ loved the Church. They should nourish and care for each other as Christ cared for the church. Through the union between the two, they become one.

#### **Gospel: John 6:60-69**

Many of Jesus' followers were still disturbed by his teaching of the living bread, which they could not yet fully understand. Jesus explained that the Spirit gives life, and flesh is unimportant. Some of the disciples decided to leave. Jesus asked if the Twelve also wanted to leave. Although they do not completely understand yet, they have enough faith in Jesus to stay because they believe he is God's holy one.

### HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

**“Joshua addressed all the people, ‘If it does not please you to serve the Lord, decide today whom you will serve... as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.’ ...But the people answered, ‘Far be it from us to forsake the Lord for the service of other gods...He performed those great miracles before our very eyes and protected us along our entire journey...Therefore we also will serve the Lord, for he is our God.’”**

Not a day goes by when we fail to make decisions. Some are important, others of little value. Many we do not ‘give a second thought to.’ As I read the instruction of Joshua, the chosen successor of Moses, I find him challenging the people – decide, and decide today. Like the people he spoke to, I probably can affirm the choice I have already made to follow and serve the Lord. But let’s take it a step further. Do I only pay lip service or do I act? Do I try to make a difference in the lives of others? What is the quality of my service?

Joshua said ‘decide today’. Are you ready?

### LECTURAS DE HOY

#### **Primera Lectura: Josué 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b**

Josué reunió a todas las tribus de Israel y les dijo que si no querían servir a Dios, debían decidir a quién servirían. La gente proclamó que Dios los había sacado de la esclavitud y los había protegido durante el trayecto. Por ello servirían al Señor su Dios y a nadie más.

#### **Segunda Lectura: Efesios 5:21-32 or 5:2a, 25-32**

Esposos y esposas debían amarse como Cristo amó la iglesia. Debían nutrir y cuidarse el uno al otro como Cristo cuidó la iglesia. A través de la unión de ambos, se vuelven uno.

#### **Evangelio: San Juan 6:60-69**

Muchos de los seguidores de Jesús estaban aún confundidos con su enseñanza del pan viviente, lo que no podían entender completamente. Jesús explicó que el Espíritu da vida, y el cuerpo no importa. Algunos de los discípulos decidieron irse. Jesús preguntó si los Doce también querían irse. A pesar de no entender completamente, tenían suficiente fé en Jesús como para quedarse porque creían que El es el Santo de Dios.

### SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

**“Entonces Josué dijo a todo el pueblo: si no están dispuestos a servir al Señor, elijan hoy a quién quieren servir... Yo y mi familia serviremos al Señor’... El pueblo respondió: ‘Estamos lejos de abandonar al Señor para servir a otros dioses... El realizó ante nuestros ojos aquellos grandes prodigios. El nos protegió en todo el camino que recorrimos ... Por eso, también nosotros serviremos al Señor, ya que él es nuestro Dios.’”**

No pasa un día sin que tengamos que tomar una decisión. Algunas son importantes, otras de poco valor. Como sea, siempre reflexionamos. Al leer las instrucciones de Josué, el elegido sucesor de Moisés, lo encuentro retando a la gente: elijan, y elijan hoy. Así como a la gente a quien se dirigía, yo probablemente puedo afirmar la elección que he hecho de seguir y servir al Señor. Pero llevémosla un paso más allá. ¿Hablo por hablar o actúo? ¿Intento hacer una diferencia en la vida de otros? ¿Cuál es la calidad de mi servicio?

Josué dijo: ‘elijan hoy’. ¿Está usted listo?

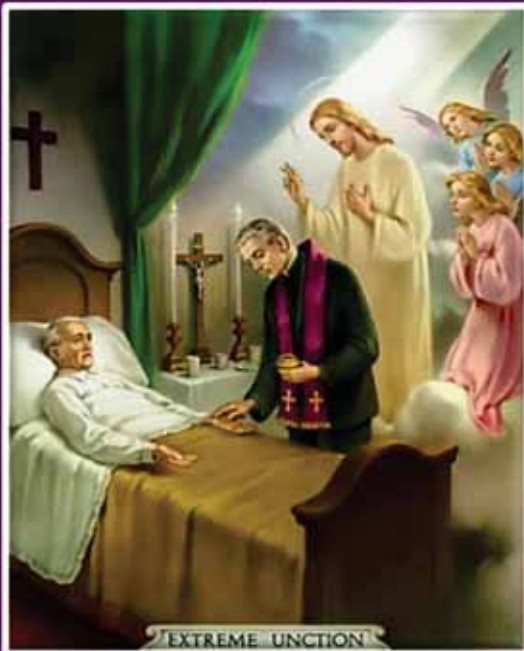

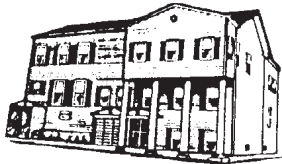
