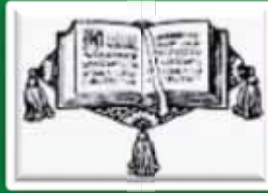

TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading: Wisdom 2:12, 17-20

Wicked people discuss their anger at the just one, because they do not like being reproached for their evil ways. They want to see if he is the Son of God, so they decide to torture him and see if God will come to defend him. They decide to condemn him to a shameful death and see if the claims are true that God will take care of him.

Second Reading: James 3:16—4:3

James discusses the importance of avoiding jealousy and strife. People should strive for peace and justice instead of concentrating on material pleasures which can tempt people to sin to obtain whatever they desire.

Gospel: Mark 9:30-37

Jesus again attempts to prepare his disciples for his death and resurrection, although they do not yet fully understand. They had been arguing over who was the most important one, but Jesus tells them whoever wants to rank first must be willing to remain a servant to all. He also tells them that anyone who welcomes a child in his name welcomes both him and God.

HIS WORD TODAY by Rev. William Reilly

“They came to Capernaum and, once inside the house, he began to ask them, ‘What were you arguing about on the way?’ But they remained silent. They had been discussing among themselves on the way who was the greatest. Then he sat down, called the Twelve, and said to them, ‘If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all.’”

How can I serve? The path to holiness requires that we humbly reach out to see Christ in the faces of those around us. “In this call to recognize Him in the poor and the suffering, we see revealed the very heart of Christ, His deepest feelings and choices, which every saint seeks to attain.” These are the words of Pope Saint John Paul, as quoted by Pope Francis.

These are the demands of Jesus with no ‘ifs and buts.’ Holiness cannot be understood or lived apart from these demands, for mercy is ‘the beating heart of the gospel.’ When He washed the feet of the disciples, He spoke by His action, what a true disciple is to do. It is when we serve we receive not only Jesus, but the One who sent Him.

LECTURAS DE HOY

Primera Lectura: Sabiduría 2:12, 17-20

Gente malvada discute su enojo contra el justo, porque no les gusta ser reprochados por sus malos actos. Quieren ver si El es el Hijo de Dios, y deciden torturarlo para ver si Dios vendrá a defenderlo. Deciden condenarlo a una muerte vergonzosa y ver si es verdad que Dios lo cuidará.

Segunda Lectura: Santiago 3:16—4:3

Santiago discute la importancia de evitar celos y disputas. La gente debe tratar de alcanzar paz y justicia en vez de concentrarse en placeres materiales que pueden tentar a la gente a pecar para obtener lo que desean.

Evangelio: San Marcos 9:30-37

Jesús de nuevo intenta preparar a sus discípulos para su muerte y resurrección, a pesar de que no comprenden totalmente. Han estado discutiendo sobre quién era el más importante, pero Jesús les dice que el que desea ser el primero debe ser un sirviente para todos los demás. Les dice también que quien acepta a un niño en su nombre, acepta a ambos: al niño y a Dios.

SU PALABRA HOY por el Rev. William Reilly

“Llegaron a Cafarnaúm y, una vez que estuvieron en la casa, les preguntó: ‘¿De qué hablaban en el camino?’. Ellos callaban, porque habían estado discutiendo sobre quién era el más grande. Entonces, sentándose, llamó a los Doce y les dijo: ‘El que quiere ser el primero, debe hacerse el último de todos y el servidor de todos’.”

¿Cómo puedo servir? El camino a la santidad requiere que humildemente nos acerquemos para ver a Jesús en las caras de quienes nos rodean. ‘En este llamado para reconocerlo en los pobres y en los que sufren, se nos revela el mismísimo corazón de Cristo, sus profundos sentimientos y elecciones, que cada santo busca alcanzar’. Estas son las palabras del Papa San Juan Pablo II, citado por el Papa Francisco.

Esto es lo que Jesús pide, sin peros ni excusas. La santidad no puede ser comprendida ni puede vivir lejos de estas demandas, ya que la misericordia ‘es el corazón latente del evangelio’. Cuando lavó los pies de los discípulos, El habló por medio de Su acción, lo que un verdadero discípulo debe hacer. Cuando servimos es cuando recibimos, no sólo a Jesús sino a aquel quien lo envió.

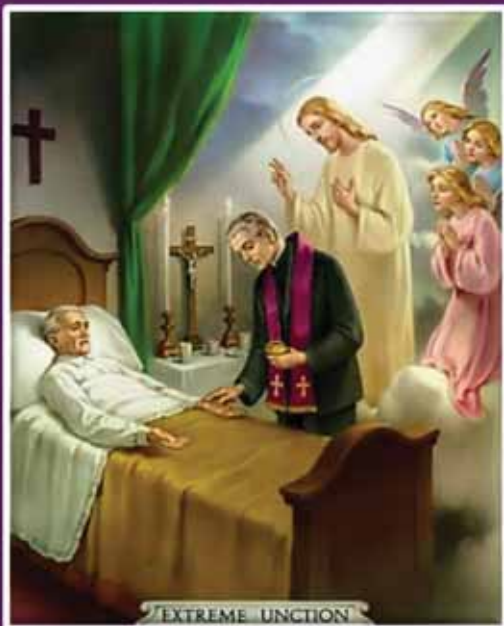
