From the Pastor's Desk

We celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity this weekend. It is a feast that highlights the most fundamental doctrine of our faith as Christians: God is *one* eternal communion of love in *three* divine persons. Making the sign of the cross, we recognize each divine person at the beginning and conclusion of all of our prayers. But this feast gives us an opportunity to ponder for a moment the depth of the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. We hold together in our minds God's unity (*one* God) as well as the relationships of infinite love between Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (*three* persons). My hope is not that we will have enough wisdom to understand completely this mystery – that would be impossible. My hope is simply that we pause to think upon the Most Holy Trinity and consider the importance of this doctrine in our lives as believers.

Do not wash your car next Saturday! Instead, come to the church so that the young people who are going to Appalachia in June can wash it for you. They will gladly accept a cash donation in exchange for their service. All the money raised will be used for construction materials for their projects in Scioto County. They are accepting certain non-perishable food items in the church next weekend, too. (See their wish list below.)
