Typically, aggression happens when a person cannot control anger or frustration. Instead of using words to express one's own emotions, a person turns to physical and/or verbal abuse. Also, when there is a general lack of respect in the home, men and women more easily fall into the temptation of hurting another in order to feel good about themselves. If you or someone you know is a victim of domestic violence, seek help immediately! Likewise, if you have trouble controlling negative emotions, consult a professional who can help. During Domestic Violence Awareness Month, let us do our part to rid this evil from our homes.
