First Reading: Exodus 24:3-8

The ratification of the covenant takes place. A portion of the calves' and goats' blood is sprinkled on the altar (representing God) and another portion on the people. Words and action unite.

Second Reading: Hebrews 9:11-15

Jesus' sacrifice is the foundation which makes Him mediator of a new covenant. This time, it is not the blood of animals used as the seal of the agreement, but rather His very own sacred blood, which was shed on the cross.

Gospel: Mark 14:12-16, 22-26

The lack of amazement on the disciples' part at Jesus' instructions is an indication that Jesus prearranged the matter with the man carrying the water jar. We read of the institution of the Holy Eucharist, the greatest treasure of the Church.

An Appeal from Fr. Thadeus, your Pastor

Dear Members and supporters of St. Boniface Parish,

Hope you are enjoying the spring/summer time. Thank you for your kind support to me personally and to our church.

I thought it is time that I give you some updates about our church finances.

While it may be difficult for many of you, here I am asking you to prayerfully consider an increase in your Sunday offerings as soon as possible. No matter how small or big the donation may be in accordance with your situation, it will be precious before the Lord.

Within the last couple of years many benevolent and dedicated members of our church have passed away to Rest in the Lord. Also several of the committed parishioners have moved elsewhere for obvious reasons.

On behalf of the parish, I thank all of you who are staying and wholeheartedly supporting our church by attendance, volunteering, prayers and generous financial offerings in different ways.

Here is a snap shot of our financial status; just the negative side FYI:

In the year 2016- 2017 (Sept to Aug) we had a deficit of \$22,000. At that time we made an appeal to you for a one-time-donation. Thanks to your benevolent support we got through that year. Since Sept last year up to April this year, there is a net loss of \$58,000 .

For the current year 2017-2018 (Sept to Aug), our accountant has projected an added up deficit of \$73,000.

Good news:

Our St. Mary's Syro-Malabar group has agreed towards an extra annual increase of 20,000 dollars from this month onwards. I appreciate their good will as they continue sharing our building space and pay us without any formal agreement until to date.

Additionally, those who can afford may give a large one-time donation to help balance our budget. In these difficult times, I humbly ask you to do your best to support our church's viability.

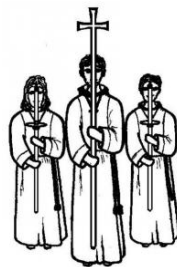
