Dear Father Thadeus:


Even though I have only been working here at the chancery for a few weeks, I have become familiar with the proposed sale of the Saint Boniface property to the Syro-Malabar Church, especially from my conversation with you. Monsignor Mustaciuolo has asked that I write as follow-up to your meeting on October 30, 2018. I am grateful to you for the attention and care that you will give to this matter.

The property, located at 5 Willow Tree Road, Wesley Hills, NY, was valued in an appraisal at \$3.6 million. As was discussed in the meeting, the archdiocese would be agreeable to a price of \$3.15 million, which would be reduced to \$3 million in view of the agreement that a Latin Rite Mass continues to be celebrated at the church on a weekly basis during the five-year period of the closing. At closing, the Syro-Malabar Church would pay cash of \$500,000 and the Parish Assistance Corporation (PAC) would provide a loan for the remaining \$2.5 million, with a 30-year term and amortization period.

Attached to this letter, please find a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Saint Boniface Parish, the Syro-Malabar Church, and the PAC outlining the proposed terms. Please review the MOU and, if agreeable, return it signed to my attention. Once we have received the signed MOU, the archdiocese's real estate division will prepare contract and loan documents.

As best as I can, I will answer any questions you may have, so please call me if I can assist.


