NOTES FROM THE LOFT

Seventh Sunday of Easter The Music of Longing and Hope May 21, 2017

As the Church anticipates the great feast of Pentecost, one might recall the adage, "Work as if all depended on you. Pray as if all depended on God." That seems to have been the mindset of the early Church.

Before ascending to the Father, the Lord gives His 'farewell to the troops'. He makes it clear to the Twelve that He has accomplished His mission. Praying to the Father in their presence He says, "I glorified You on earth by accomplishing the work that You gave Me to do...I revealed Your Name... to those whom You gave me...the words you gave to Me, I have given to them... (T)hey have believed that You sent Me...I PRAY for them..." He comforts His disciples, "I will not leave you orphans... (the) Father will give you...the Spirit of truth". He "enjoins them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to WAIT for the 'promise of the Father'. In a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit. You will receive POWER when the Holy Spirit comes upon you...and you will be my witnesses...to the ends of the earth...Go...and make disciples of all baptizing...teaching...I am with you always!"

Next Sunday's Entrance Antiphon, Responsorial Psalm and Alleluia verse are like a long-distance conversation between lovers. The texts express the desire of the human heart to be heard by God, to see His Face. The Lord responds that He will return, and we will rejoice!

Next Sunday's Choir music will feature three contemporary pieces of music which really capture the poignancy of the Lord's departure and the longing of His Bride for their reunion. All three are the work of founding members of the St. Louis Jesuits. Tim Manion's composition, THIS ALONE #401, echoes the psalm and directs us to WAIT on the Lord in hope. Fr. Bob Dufford, SJ gives us AS I HAVE DONE FOR YOU #143. Verse two, in particular, refers to Jesus' imminent ascension and His promise to return. JESUS, THE LORD #726 is based on texts from Philippians and Acts. The work of Fr. Roc O'Connor, SJ, it will be sung by the Choir for the first time next week.
