AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round-trip coach class on Delta & KLM Airlines. Meals served in flight.

LAND TRANSPORTATION & SERVICES: By deluxe airconditioned motor coach with professional driver, services of an English-speaking Tour Director, local guides, all admission & entrance fees and transfers to and from international airports. Mass scheduled daily. Daily schedule as per your itinerary, however we reserve the right to modify any itinerary if circumstances deem necessary.

LODGING: First-class accommodations, based upon double occupancy with <u>limited</u> single accommodations available at an additional charge of \$595.

MEALS: Daily Breakfast Buffet and Six Dinners.

ALSO INCLUDED IN PRICE: All taxes, including airport taxes. Gratuities for tour directors, local guides, bus drivers, porters, wait staff, housekeeping and front desk personnel. Tipping will be conducted by a tour leader during the course of your tour.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: The cost of obtaining your passport and visa fees to some countries, meals not included in the itinerary, wines, liquors, bottled waters, coffee or tea, personal items, laundry services, room service charges, long-distance phone calls, excess baggage, airport service charges and any sightseeing not included in the itinerary.

GROUP REQUIREMENT: The minimum number of passengers needed to assure a group's departure is 15. We reserve the right to cancel up to 30 days from departure should the total number of registered passengers be fewer than 15. If there are fewer than 15 passengers, Pilgrimage Tours will do all that is possible to assure your group's departure without having to resort to charging a supplemental fee for the group. If Pilgrimage Tours cancels, you will receive a full refund.

DEPOSIT AND FULL PAYMENT: A deposit/payment of \$500 towards the price of the tour, per person is required to book your reservation. The balance is to be paid in full 60 days prior to departure; April 11, 2018. Balances not paid by this date may be subject to a \$100 late payment fee. Reservations made within 30 days of departure may be subject to a \$100 late reservation fee. Upon receipt of your completed registration form and deposit, a confirmation invoice along with a travel insurance brochure will be mailed to you.

INSURANCE: Trip Cancellation and Interruption Insurance is highly recommended. Cancellation fees are covered by CSA Travel Protection's plan, as long as your premium has been paid, your policy is in effect and the reason for your canceling is insurable. DAILY MASS AT THE HOLY SITES

A CATHOLIC PILGRIMAGE TOUR TO THE CZECH REPUBLIC, POLAND & AUSTRIA

June 11, 2018 - Monday NEW YORK / CZECH REPUBLIC

This afternoon we gather at New York's JFK Airport for our overnight flight to Prague. Meals are served on board.

June 12, 2018 - Tuesday PRAGUE

This morning we arrive in Prague, capital of the Czech Republic, and are met by our Pilgrimage Tours' tour director. We leave the airport and enjoy a motor coach tour of Prague, including a stop in downtown Prague, where we will visit and celebrate Mass at the Church of Our Lady Victorious and visit its Holy Infant Jesus of Prague Shrine. We arrive at our hotel for check-in. Dinner and overnight in Prague.

June 13, 2018 - Wednesday PRAGUE

Today we enjoy a guided tour beginning with a walk across the famous Charles Bridge with its baroque statues and where we will see artists, musicians and souvenir merchants. As we enter Old Town, we will see many interesting shops en route to Prague's historic Old Town Square, where we will see the famous 15th century astronomical clock that is a fascinating display of dials, hands and figures. We also visit and celebrate Mass in the Gothic Tyn Church, dating from the 14th century, followed by free time for lunch.

In the afternoon we will visit Prague Castle and see its gallery with paintings from the most important masters of Renaissance: Titian, Leonardo da Vinci, Raphael, Breughel, Holbein, Dürer and many others. In Saint Vitus Cathedral we will see some of the most prized relics of Czech history including tombs of Czech kings, coronation jewels, and some outstanding artworks. Within the Castle complex, we also visit the Romanesque Saint George's Basilica. Dinner and overnight in Prague.

June 14, 2018 - Thursday PRAGUE / SVATA HORA

This morning we enjoy a drive to the Sanctuary of Svata Hora, a hilltop shrine featuring a renowned miraculous statue of the Virgin Mary and a spectacular basilica with its silver altar and magnificent frescoes and paintings. Following Mass at the shrine, we return to Prague for a visit to Wenceslas Square and free time for shopping. This evening dinner will be on our own in Prague. Overnight in Prague.

June 15, 2018 - Friday PRAGUE / OLOMOUC / KRAKOW

Following breakfast this morning, we depart Prague for Poland. En route, we will stop in Olomouc for free time for lunch near its main square where we will see the impressive Holy Trinity Column. Next we arrive in Krakow, for centuries the residence of the Polish Kings. We arrive in the heart of Old Town Krakow in Market Square for a visit and celebration of Mass in the 14th century Gothic Saint Mary's Basilica. Inside we see the world-famous Altar of the Virgin Mary, the largest of its kind in Europe, and the Altars of Our Lady of Loreto and Saint Stanislaus. We will also see the Chapels of Our Lady of Czestochowa and Saint Anthony. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.

June 16, 2018 - Saturday KRAKOW / WADOWICE / CZESTOCHOWA

This morning we drive to Wadowice, the birthplace of Karol Wojtyla, who today is named Saint John Paul II or Saint John Paul the Great. Here we visit his childhood home, today a museum, as well as the Basilica of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary to see the baptismal font where Karol Wojtyla was baptized as an infant. In the afternoon we arrive at Czestochowa and enjoy a visit and celebration of Mass in the Monastery at Jasna Gora, one of the most famous Marian Shrines in Europe. Here we will see the miraculous icon of Our Lady with the Child Jesus, also known as the Black Madonna. Also venerated as the "Oueen of Poland", it has become the country's national symbol. Dinner this evening will be on our own in Krakow. Overnight in Krakow.

June 17, 2018 - Sunday KRAKOW / WIELICZKA / LAGIEWNIKI

Today we will visit Lagiewniki and the Shrine of Blessed Faustina at the Convent of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. Here we will pray at the Shrine of Divine Mercy as well as recite the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. We pause for our own celebration of Mass in one of the Sanctuary's chapels. In the afternoon we will drive to the town of Wieliczka for a memorable visit to the Wieliczka Salt Mines. We return to Krakow for dinner and overnight.

June 18, 2018 - Monday KRAKOW / KLOSTERNEUBURG / VIENNA

Today we will drive to Austria and its capital Vienna. Prior to arriving in Vienna, we will visit the Klosterneuburg Monastery, a 12th century Augustinian monastery, where we celebrate Mass in the Cathedral of the Monastery, followed by a guided tour of the monastery's winery. Dinner this evening will be at our own expense at Stiftskeller, a restaurant managed by the monastery. Following dinner, we arrive in Vienna for overnight.

June 19, 2018 - Tuesday VIENNA

This morning we will visit Saint Stephen's Cathedral, where we see the miraculous image of Our Lady of Mariapocs. Following Mass at the Cathedral, we enjoy a visit to the beautiful gardens of the Belvedere Palace. Following free time for lunch, we enjoy a tour of Vienna's historic center, including a visit to the Church of Saint Charles Borromeo (Karlskirche), followed by a visit to the Augustinian Church. The remainder of our day is planned for shopping, including a visit to the Xocolat chocolate factory. Dinner and overnight in Vienna.

June 20, 2018 - Wednesday VIENNA / MELK / MARIAZELL

Today we enjoy a day-trip outside Vienna, beginning with a visit to the famous Melk Abbey, rising above the banks of the Danube River. At over 900 years old, the Melk Abbey is one of the finest religious sites in Austria where black robed monks still stroll amidst marble sculptures and frescoed walls. We celebrate Mass in the Golden Abbey Church. In the afternoon we drive to Mariazell, the most visited Marian Shrine in Central Europe, nestled high atop the Alpine Mountains. Here we will visit the basilica and see a miraculous statue of the Virgin Mary housed in the Chapel of Miracles. Following free time at the shrine's gift shop, we return to Vienna for dinner and overnight.

June 21, 2018 - Thursday VIENNA / NEW YORK

Following breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our return flight home. Though our pilgrimage has come to an end, the blessings of our encounters with the Lord, Our Lady, and the saints are certain to strengthen and encourage us throughout our lifelong pilgrimage.
