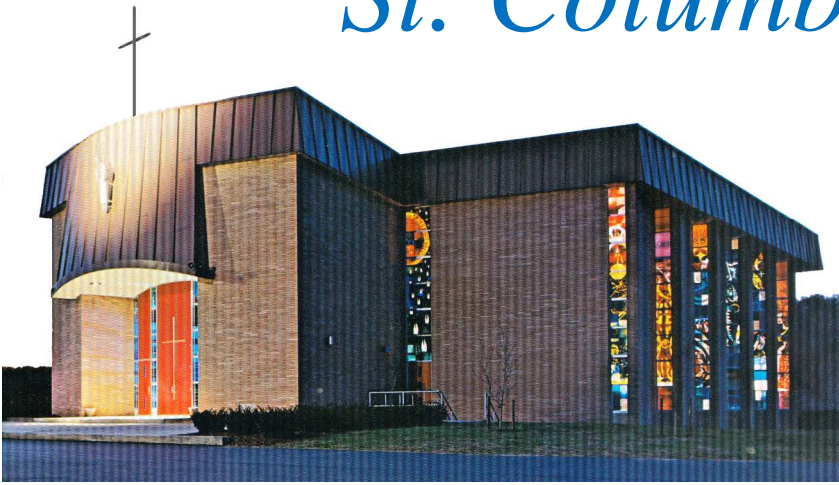

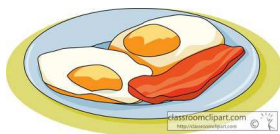

**SACRED RELICS OF THE SAINTS:
TREASURES OF THE CHURCH**

St. Columbanus Parish is much blessed to have a presentation and exposition of the sacred relics on Monday, February 20th at 7:00 p.m. at St. Columbanus Church. We hope it will bring many healing graces to our community. You are invited to venerate over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the “Little Flower”), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Faustina Kowalska, St. John Paul, St. Teresa of Calcutta, Bl. Pier Giorgio, Ven. Fr. Michael McGivney and others. In addition, a portion of the veil of Our Lady will be present, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. In the Church’s history many miracles and healings have been worked in the presence of relics, and many have been healed through this ministry. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.
