Lent is the primary penitential season in the Church's liturgical year, reflecting the forty days Jesus spent in the desert fasting and praying. It is the forty days liturgical season of fasting praying in preparation for Easter. We encourage all of our parishioners to please join us during our bilingual services of the way of the cross every Friday



after the 8am and 7pm mass at **Blessed Sacrament**. During Lent abstinence from meat on Friday's is obligatory. Abstinence must be observed by all baptized Catholics 14t yrs. Old and above. All those exempt are the sick, frail and pregnant and nursing women.
