Cardinal's Annual Appeal:

Many ask how the Church is paying for programs and settlements in response to the sex abuse scandals. In light of the most recent crisis, His Eminence Cardinal Dolan has clarified that charitable donations will not be used to fund the Reconciliation and Compensation Program, saying, "Please know that no gifts to the Cardinal's Annual Stewardship or the Renew and Rebuild campaign are being used to fund the program". The Archdiocese has borrowed money against the land they own under the Palace Hotel, and will repay the loan with the sale of other properties over time through other real estate holding.
