From the Pastor's Desk

Let us hear again Jesus saying to us: **“When you pray...”** As we reflect on those words during this Lenten time, let us resolve to work on our prayer life. In 1 Thessalonians 5:18, St. Paul encourages us to pray without ceasing. Be in constant prayer. Pray for your family and friends, for those who suffer and for the church in the world. Do meditative reading. Nourish your faith by spending time in quiet reading and reflection. Prayerful reading of God’s word each day will open your heart to the Spirit, and let God’s thoughts and ways influence yours.

Explore the possibility of praying, even privately, the Church’s Liturgy of the Hours. Participate in Mass at least one extra day each week and if you already attend Mass seven times a week, then add at least one-half hour each week for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. Pray the Stations of the Cross privately or with others. Spending time with Jesus in prayer will be a great boon for your spiritual life.

Let us hear again Jesus saying to us, **“When you fast...”** Reconsider the Church’s invitation to fast for specific periods. In the gospel of Mark 9:29 we are reminded us that there are certain things who are achieved by fasting and prayer. Pay special attention to the one hour fast before receiving Holy Communion. Remember that Fridays in Lent are days of fasting and abstinence. Give up meat or desirable foods during Lent, especially on Friday, the day of Christ’s saving death on the cross. Fasting will increase your desire for Christ and His spiritual gifts and these will not be withheld from you as you seek them. And empty stomach can lead to more attentive prayer. Give the money you saved on the food to others in alms.

Hear again Jesus saying to us, **“When you give alms...”** Consider almsgiving as a way of carrying out the works of mercy – corporal and spiritual. Do good works. Help those in need. Pray for them and be ready to serve them in their time of need. Lent would be a good time to refresh your memory as to what these are. In this regard, you will be ministering to your brothers and sisters and you will hear Jesus say that whatever you do to the least of His sisters and brothers, you are doing to Him. Help the poor and support the good works of the church. Give cheerfully to God who has given us everything we have.

And we are to do all these things quietly and without display. No one should even know we are praying more, sharing more or doing without things. Once we draw attention to ourselves doing these things, **they have lost their real purpose which is to bring us closer to God and his ways.**


