IT TAKES A PARISH

Some may remember Hilary Clinton's book, *It Takes a Village: and Other Lessons Children Teach Us*. The phrase finds its origin in from different versions of a West African proverb that suggests the role an entire community plays in raising a child. It's assumed that everyone would have a personal interest in ensuring that children are cared for and safe and taught well.

Some years ago, while traveling to Ghana to visit the homeland of both Father Simon and Father John, I had occasion to spend time with the Vicar General of the Sunyani Diocese, Monsignor George Kwami Kumi, and his mother. She lived in the same home which he grew up in, a small compound that several other families lived in as well. Monsignor said that in their common home, every parent watched over everyone else's children and that the responsibility of a neighbor was understood and anticipated by all. His spoke with great affection and appreciation for the love and happiness he knew from that place.

I suppose we try our best to create a similar culture in our own communities. Our complicated and much too busy world constrains the kind of sentiment and personal devotion that inspires "It takes a village...." More often than not, it becomes too easy to delegate that responsibility - after the parents - to public institutions. Of course, we love hearing about the teacher or the police officer who go beyond what's normally expected of them and make the difference of love in the lives of children. Yet, try as our institutions might, they will never really be able to represent themselves as family and friends.

Our parish honors at the 11:00 am Mass today - and with a well-deserved brunch - the catechists who with love and devotion shared their faith with the children of our Faith Formation Program. Their love of Christ reminds us of the heart of our mission to form children in the Faith. "Who is my mother? Who are my brothers?" Jesus once asked in a teaching moment (Matthew 12:48), then sweeping his hands and arms over the people gathered to hear him. "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of my heavenly Father is my brother, and sister, and mother."

Unlike other "institutions," a parish can be - much like the place where Monsignor George was raised - an extension of the family, forming a genuine community of friends. In the deepest way

imaginable, through our sacramental prayer and worship, we are related to one another, possessing the same vision, the same hope, and the same concerns, particularly for those - like our children - who are the least among us. Naturally, the catechetical mission then takes a parish, an entire parish.

"If you are friends with Christ," the French writer François Mauriac wrote, "many others will warm themselves at your fire. ... On the day when you no longer burn with love, many will die of the cold." Happily, our catechists, friends with Christ, burn with the fire of His love and so are able to warm the children with their fire.
