Thursday, December 8, 2016 is the Feast of The Immaculate Conception, Patroness of the United States of America. Masses on the Holy Day will be at 9 a.m. and 12 noon and a bi-lingual Mass at 7:30 p.m.

At Communion when you receive the Body of Christ the Sacred Host must be consumed at that time. It is not appropriate to carry the Host to your seat or to consume the Host at a later date. Also, for whatever reason after receiving the Host and you are not able to consume it, you should give it back to the Priest, Deacon or the Ministers of the Eucharistic. The Host, the Body of Christ, should never be discarded.

We are told that the light always breaks the darkness. Jesus Christ, the Light of the World, can break any darkness that is preventing us from living a happy and peaceful life. Come join us on **Thursday, December 8, 2016 at 7 p.m. in front of the Rectory**, for our 2nd Annual Tree Lighting Ceremony celebrating our confidence that at Christmas, the true Light, Jesus Christ, will find a way into our hearts.
