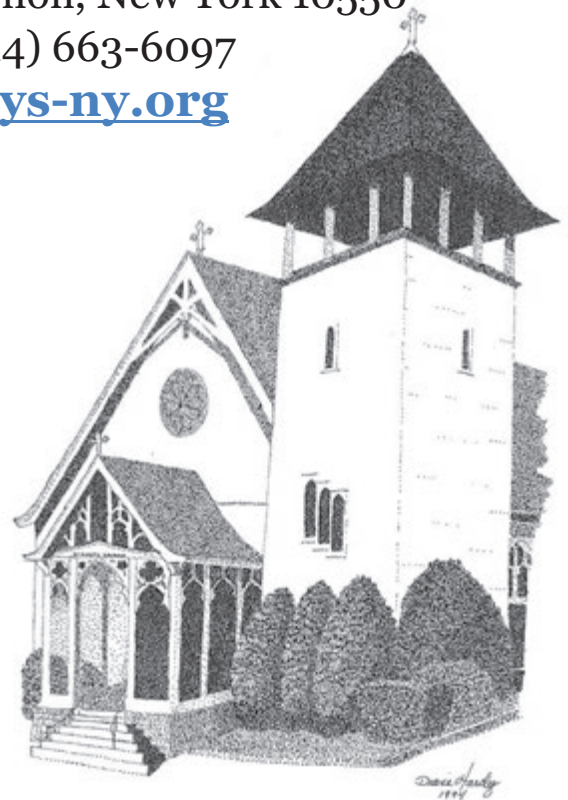

ASH WEDNESDAY

This Wednesday, March 6, 2019 is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of The Lenten Season. Masses on Ash Wednesday will be 9 a.m. in English, 12noon in English and 7:30 p.m. in Spanish & English. Ashes will be imposed at all the Masses

CHURCH REGULATIONS

HERE ARE THE CHURCH REGULATIONS FOR FASTING AND ABSTINENCE DURING LENT: Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent* and Good Friday. Everyone 18 or older, and under 59 years of age, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

Todos los mayores de 18 años y menores de 59 años de edad deben ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo, solo se permite una comida sin carne completa. Se pueden tomar otras dos comidas sin carne, suficientes para mantener la fuerza, de acuerdo con las necesidades de cada uno, pero juntas no deben ser iguales a otra comida completa. Comer entre comidas no está permitido. Cuando la salud o la capacidad para trabajar se verían seriamente afectadas, la ley no obliga. Los católicos no deben excusarse a la ligera de estas prácticas penitenciales mínimas prescritas.
