Mass Intentions



As you may be aware, it is a custom in the church to ask that a Mass be offered for the special intentions of the living and deceased in order to show our prayerful concern for them and their loved ones. Many people offer a Mass intention for the repose of the soul of a loved one, but it's also common to request a Mass in thanksgiving to our Lord, for health and blessing or special intentions. Intentions can

even be offered for someone on their birthday, anniversary, or wedding day.

What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone?

The Mass is the greatest prayer we have since it is the sacrifice of Christ Himself. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul. Pope Leo XIII in his encyclical "Mirae caritatis" (1902) beautifully elaborated this point and emphasized the connection between the communion of saints with the Mass: "The grace of mutual love among the living, strengthened and increased by the sacrament of the Eucharist, flows, especially by virtue of the Sacrifice [of the Mass], to all who belong to the communion of saints. For the communion of saints is simply ... the mutual sharing of help, atonement, prayers and benefits among the faithful, those already in the heavenly fatherland, those consigned to the purifying fire, and those still making their pilgrim way here on earth."

Parishioners desiring to have a Mass offered for a special intention are invited to make arrangements by visiting the Parish Office during normal office hours. We do have many Mass times available for your personal intention request.
