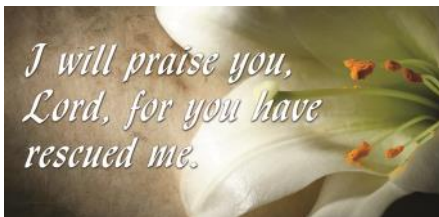

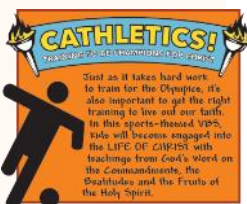

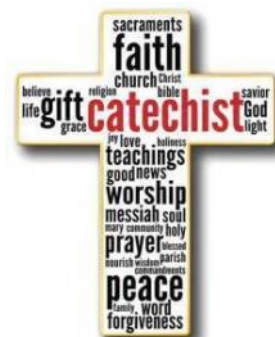


Director of Religious Education
