CYO Basketball Program

2018- 2019

All registrations will be done via mail, email, or in person after select CCD classes. The cutoff date for registration is October 20, 2018. Parishioners of St. Joseph – Immaculate Conception Catholic Church are eligible to participate. There may also be openings for non-parishioners. Those children are encouraged to register and will be notified as to their eligibility. The Archdiocese of New York has instituted eligibility requirements that must be followed so as to avoid disqualification of a team and/or parish from CYO competition. Home games will be played at St. Joseph's gymnasium (grades 4, 5 & 6) or at Millbrook Middle School (grades 7 & 8).

The CYO fee for this season is \$95.00 per child or \$170.00 for two children in the same family. The CYO fee includes the team entry and tournament fees, rental fees for gym space, payment for referees, purchase of equipment, and maintenance fees. If your child is in need of a uniform, the cost for a full uniform is \$32.00. A jersey is \$22.00 and shorts are \$10.00. The fees are to be paid by check payable to St. Joseph's CYO when you sign your child up. No cash please!!

The uniforms come in the following sizes: youth large and xl, men's small, medium or large for all shorts and boy's jerseys; youth large and xl and women's small, medium or large for all girl's jerseys. Please provide the correct spelling of your child's last name, the preferred number and the size of the uniform needed. We will try to accommodate number requests. If you have a uniform from last year, please provide us with that number on your registration form.

Coaches will contact players in late October with regard to practice sessions. The first games will be held the first weekend in December.

CYO Athletic Code of Ethics

CYO athletic competition is a means of training young people to enjoy healthful sports but with the end, that win or lose, they learn to respect opponents, officials, and spectators.

It is important that all concerned with the CYO athletic program follow this code:

- To emphasize the proper ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
- To stress the values derived from being fair.
- To show cordial courtesy to opponents and officials.
- To establish a happy relationship between visitors and hosts.
- To respect the integrity and judgment of officials.
- To achieve through understanding and acceptance of the rules and standards of eligibility.
- To encourage leadership, use of initiative and good judgment by the players.
- To recognize that the purpose of competition is to promote the physical, mental, social and emotional well-being of the players.
- To remember that a contest is only an activity and not a matter of life or death for player, coach, school, parish, official and fan.
