***Disposal of Palms and other blessed items*** – The palm you receive on Palm Sunday is blessed, and thereby becomes a sacramental. Sacramentals must be treated with respect and should never be put in the trash. Blessed palms should be returned to nature: buried in the ground or burned and the ashes spread outside. Or, you may bring old palms, blessed candles, prayer books, etc that are in need of disposal to Hostyn Church by Friday, April 19, and they will be burned in the Easter Vigil fire. A box will be placed in the Narthex for the items.
