- **Saturday, February 9th & Sunday, February 10th (if needed) – Clean out the garages**
 - **Tuesday, February 15th – People can start leaving things in the garage**
 - **Saturday, April 13th – move all tag sale items in to Madonna Hall**
 - **Tuesday, May 14th – Last day to except donations**
- Saturday, May 18th & Sunday, May 19th –Tag Sale**

Saturday, February 9th- need volunteers to help clean out and go through all items still in the garage from prior sales.**Tuesday, February 15th**- Signs will go up on the garages that items can be left; bulletin needs to announce this also.**Saturday, April 13th**- move all items (except furniture???) into Madonna Hall; need to contact all schools, scouts, etc. for students to help with this for community service hours.**Tuesday, May 14th** – last day to except donations from the public; this date might need to be changed depending on the number of committee members and how the organization, pricing, etc. is going with what already has been donated. Might need to rethink this date to make it a week earlier???? Further discussion at further meetings.**Saturday May 18th and Sunday May 19th**- Tag Sale Hours: 9-6:30 on Saturday and 9-2 on Sunday**Committee Discussion:**

- Need a “committee” of several chair people to run the Tag Sale this year.
- Need to be opened to addressing new ideas to help with the process of getting ready for the Tag Sale
- Per discussion, using the garages to stage the furniture for sale will cut down on the work needed by leaving them in the garages and setting up in there.
- Number of hours people work for setting up

In the past Judy has worked in the garages to organize the donation prior to bringing into Madonna Hall; new chairs might want to just wait till April 13th and bring in to hall. More discussion is needed on this area.**Furniture Items for this year:**

- See if furniture being donated can be delivered week of April 21st
 - Start a list for volunteers to be able to pick up donated furniture from various locations and bring to the garages.
- See about possibly setting up the furniture for sale in the garage instead of moving it again from garage to Madonna Hall (will give extra room in Madonna Hall and lessen what has to be moved); also can spread out the furniture in the garages. Would need lighting and would need volunteers to man just the furniture sale.
