Everyone is invited to the Memorial Day Mass at the Altar of the Saint Thomas the Apostle Cemetery.

MONDAY, MAY 27TH

**IF YOU HAVE A LOVED ONE INTERRED IN THE CEMETERY, PLEASE GO TO THEIR GRAVE AT 10AM.
THE LITURGY WILL BEGIN AT 10:30AM.**

The perimeter of the burial area will be incensed - when we incense we watch the smoke rise to heaven symbolic of our prayers rising to heaven.

Each grave will be sprinkled with water symbolic of our Baptism - into the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. After each grave has been sprinkled please return to the Sanctuary/Altar area for the Liturgy.

If you do not have a loved one or friend interred in our parish cemetery, please remain in the Sanctuary area and remember your loved ones interred elsewhere.

Please bring your own folding chair for your comfort. In case of inclement weather, we will gather in the Church.
