
Ascension of the Lord May 8, 2016



Reflection on the Scriptures

As He blessed, He left them, and was taken up to heaven."—Luke 24:51

Jesus ascended in "mid-blessing." The apostles responded by "blessing God" (Luke 24:53, our transation!). These are the final words of Luke's Gospel. The last word for Luke is that the ascended Christ is blessing us for which we are blessing Him. "When He ascended on high, He...gave gifts to men" (Ephesians 4:8; see Psalm 68:19) "that He might fill all men with His gifts" (Ephesians 4:10). When Jesus ascended, He fulfilled the prophecy: "From this day, I will bless!" (Haggai 2:19) Therefore, "bless the Lord, O my soul; and all my being, bless His holy name" (Psalm 103:1).

To receive the blessings of the ascended Christ, let us together devote ourselves to constant prayer (Acts 1:14). Let us fervently pray the first of all novenas, the Pentecost novena. Jesus will bless us with the Holy Spirit of blessing. "Within a few days" we will be renewed in the power of the Spirit (Acts 1:5). Blessed are those who worship the ascended Christ and pray for a new Pentecost. Blessed are those "baptized with the Holy Spirit" (Acts 1:5). In the ascended Christ, be blessed, "be a blessing" (Genesis 12:2), and "bless the Lord at all times" (Psalm 34:2).
