This group of dedicated knitters has delivered more than 400 shawls to parishioners and friends. Each shawl provides comfort after a loss or in time of illness or recovery.

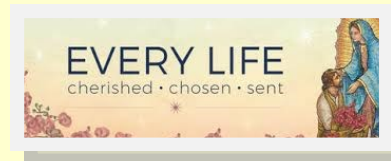

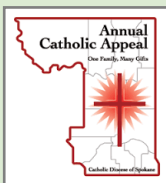
