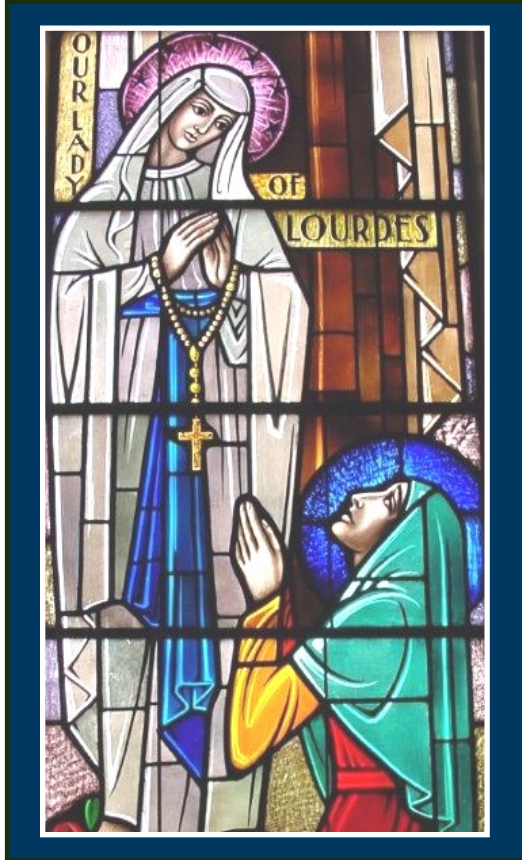

CATHOLIC YOUTH CONFERENCE (CYC)

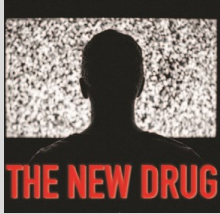

THIS WEEK AT CATALDO CATHOLIC SCHOOL

Mr. O'Brien's 8th Grade



This week at Cataldo Catholic School, we take a peek at what's happening in Mr. O'Brien's 8th-grade classes. While praying the Lourdes Novena Prayer, students are also learning about St. Bernadette and the series of Marian apparitions she witnessed in Southern France in 1858.

Beyond the historical facts, students also learned how the Church determines authentic miracles, and what Mary meant when she said, "I am the Immaculate Conception." Writing students are drafting 2,500 expository essays on a variety of topics (to a backdrop of wailing and gnashing of teeth). Planetary Science students are learning and practicing the techniques of Greek librarian and mathematician Eratosthenes, who accurately determined the circumference of the Earth more than 2,000 years ago.
