SOUPer BOWL OF CARING

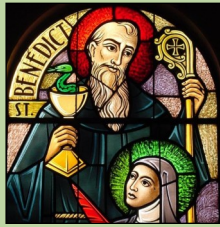

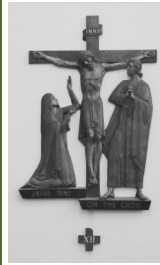
REGISTRATION & INFORMATION
