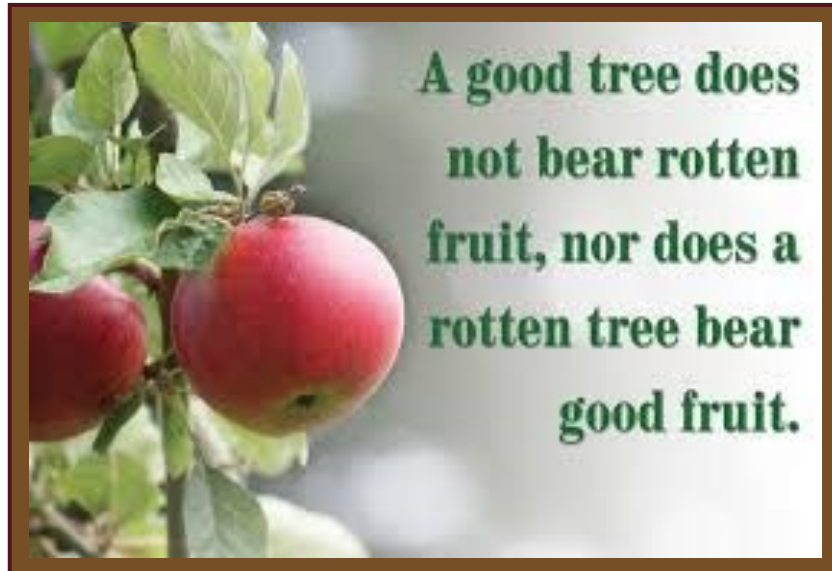

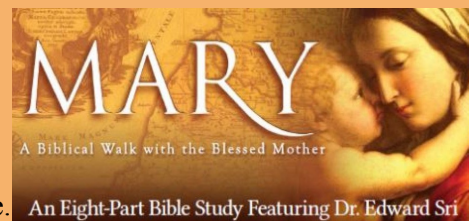

As part of the 2002 Dallas Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, parishes around the nation are asked to keep their parishioners informed on their safety guidelines. Let us find some encouragement in the work that is being done in our own diocese to protect our youth.

* Over 5,200 children and youth in our diocese were trained this past year in sexual abuse prevention.

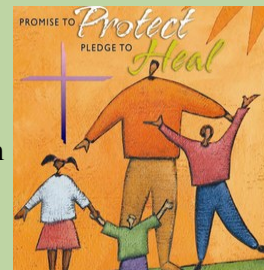
* 100% of our diocesan clergy have been trained in sexual abuse prevention and have a background check every five years.

* 100% of our diocesan, school, and parish employees have been trained in sexual abuse prevention and have a background check every five years.

* Over 2,000 current volunteers who work with children and youth have been trained in sexual abuse prevention and have a background check every five years.

* In addition, all active clergy, employees and volunteers are asked to complete annual online sexual abuse prevention training.

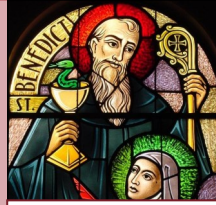
STATIONS OF THE CROSS & SOUP SUPPER
