THE CINDY PRETTI SCHOLARSHIP was established by Cindy's family. Cindy was a Sacred Heart student from 1987 until 1996. After completing elementary school, she enrolled in Immaculate Conception High School in Memphis. In her junior year, she was killed in an automobile accident on her way to visit the Ole Miss Campus on March 20, 1999. Cindy loved Sacred Heart School and Church. The Scholarship Fund was established as a testimonial to her spirit and memory.

Once again this year two graduates of Sacred Heart School that will continue their Catholic education were awarded scholarships. The recipients of the Cindy Pretti scholarships this year are Jeremy Suico and Valerie Espinoza.

The Scholarship was increased last year to \$2,000 in part due to the generosity of our Holy Spirit Church family, especially the Men's Association who continue their faithfulness to this noble cause.

HOW DOES PARISH REGISTRATION HELP THE PARISH? Many ways. First of all, who is part of this community; who helps to make it what it is; who can the parish staff count on to help with the many significant programs and events in the parish.

Then, of course, it helps to know how many families are 'part of us'? How many children can we expect to enroll in the first communion class this year so we can be prepared? How many children can we expect to enroll in Confirmation preparation? What can we expect from Young Adults? Are we addressing the needs of young married couples? Who are they? Should we have a vacation bible school? Who has what talents available for helping with many jobs needed for parish maintenance? How can we make a realistic parish budget? Will we have enough or will we have to cut some things out? With a small parish staff, many helping hands are needed.
