


ATTENTION YOUTH!!!

GO, MAKE DISCIPLES (Pope Francis) "In Revelation, Jesus says that he is at the door and knocks," Bergoglio told his fellow electors. "Obviously, the text refers to his knocking from the outside in order to enter. But I think about the times

in which Jesus knocks from within so that we will let him come out. The self-referential Church keeps Jesus Christ within herself and does not let him out." "In short", he said, "the church has a choice: to come out of herself and evangelize, being true to the Gospel imperative, or to remain closed within herself and be 'sick.'
