THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

One of the seven sacraments is the Anointing of the Sick. We read in the Letter of James: " Are there people ill among you? Let them send for the priests of the Church and let the priests pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord." A native of Italy, Mother Cabrini formed a community of religious sisters that assisted Italian immigrants coming to the United State and South America. 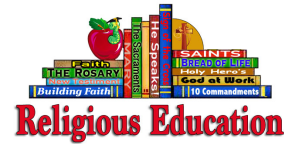

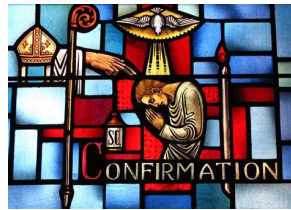

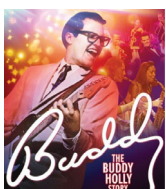
