Dear 4th and 5th Grade Students and Parents,

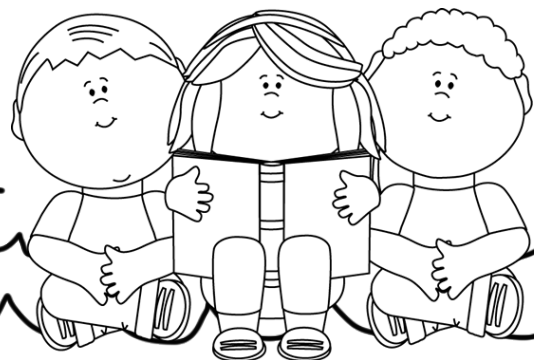
