What must I do to attain eternal life? (Luke 10:15-37).

“Our family has a wilderness lodge in Alaska where I’ve worked as a guide for about twenty years. Basically, I keep people safe all summer while I show them big furry bears and whales bigger than our boat. Two years ago I was on the job when my doctor called.

The survival rate is less than twenty percent. I prayed, “God how do I do this? You will lead me. You will direct me. You will guide me.”

My wife and kids rallied around me. We spent time in daily prayer and worship, and they prayed scripture over me. It was five months of chemo, six weeks of radiation on a daily basis and then a ten-hour surgery involving two specialists,” Jordan and Jennie Hess, Alaska.

How priceless for a father, mother, and children to center themselves in the Lord our God. Belief in God and faith in Him is the key to bear trials and tribulations in our lives. With the love of God and His loving care that carries us daily, we can tackle and accomplish the impossible. In addition is the support and prayers of families, friends, and the Church.

We must never give up and throw-in the towel when we are in trials and being challenged by the snare of the world.

We need to remain faithful and put our belief in God. He is our shelter and comfort during hardships and the burdens of life. Be steadfast and be firm in your faith. Safeguard the Commandments of God with your dear life. Never let it go by always insisting on living the truth, the way, the life that God continuously gives us. Prayers bring peace in joyful times as well as challenging times. Find time to pray, it is an intimate conversation you will have with Jesus.

When all else fails, the Lord has got your back!

PARISH MEMBERSHIP: We joyfully welcome new members to our parish. Please register at the parish office during business hours. We also ask that you let us know if you plan to move from the parish.

INFANT BAPTISM: Parents must be registered and regularly attending the Sunday Eucharist to begin Baptism preparation. Baptismal Preparation is held quarterly. Call the parish office to for next scheduled date. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the first and third Sunday of every month.

MARRIAGE: If one of the engaged couple (or their parents) is registered at St. Mary's arrangements may be made personally by the couple at least six months in advance. 8-10 months is preferred.

SICK CALLS: We are happy to visit the sick and bring Communion to them. Please notify the parish office.

ANNULMENT PROCESS: If you are contemplating filing for an annulment; know that it is a healing process. It takes up to 18 months for the Tribunal to complete each case, so please take that into consideration. Call the parish office for more information.
