Abortion and neglect of the poor, elderly, widows, orphans, etc, is the opposite of these teachings. It is a reversal of justice. It is a destruction of the helpless, rather than a rescue of them. If God's people do not intervene to save those whose lives are attacked, then the people are not pleasing or worshipping Him.
