**From the Pastors Desk**

### **Question of the week: Why do we believe that the Bible is an inspired book?**

It is not because it inspires us but because the Bible itself says that it is inspired (Sacred Scripture): Biblically speaking, "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness" (2 Tim 3:16). Personally speaking from our faith, we believe, the Holy Spirit tells us that the Bible is inspired. We are "convinced" that it is the word of God, and we get a positive "feeling" that it is inspired by God.

### **The Catholic position:**

As the first step we prove the reliability of the Bible insofar as it is history. From that we conclude that a Church with infallible teaching authority was founded by Christ. And then we take the word of that infallible Church that the Bible is inspired. Without the existence of the Church, we could never know whether the Bible is inspired.

The Church infallibly teaches that the Old Testament books are also inspired because Jesus and his apostles believed in them as inspired books and taught that truth. The New Testament books are recorded the inspired history of Jesus and his Church.

Inspiration of the Bible means that the Holy Spirit as principal author of Sacred Scripture influenced the sacred writers in three ways: 1) He illuminated the mind of the sacred writer. 2) Holy Spirit moved the will of the sacred writers to write freely, though infallibly, what God wished. 3. The Holy Spirit aided the sacred writers in the work of composition.

### **Thought for the week: Healing touch of Jesus!**

The leper in the gospel of this weekend, prays to Jesus: "Lord, if you choose, you can make me clean." By the healing of the leper, first, Jesus disproves that leprosy is a punishment for sinners rather he reveals God's compassion for sinners. Second, Jesus discloses his messianic power by his healing of the leper. Third, Just as Jesus identifies himself with the leper, we must identify ourselves with the suffering people in our midst. Listening to the prayers of the leper, because Jesus chooses, healing becomes possible, so also, if we choose, there will be a way to help others and to receive God's blessings. Where there is a will, there is a way!
