From the Pastors Desk



The Feast of Holy Trinity

Some references of Trinity in the Bible: First, the Annunciation (Lk1:26-38) describes how God the Father sent the Angel Gabriel to Mary, to announce to her that Holy Spirit would “overshadow” her and that God the Son, would be made flesh in her womb. Second, during the Baptism of Jesus, (Mt3:16-17), all three persons of Trinity were present: the Holy Spirit is descending on Jesus the Son in the form of a dove, while the voice of God the Father is heard from the cloud. Third, the preaching mission given by Risen Jesus to his disciples in today’s gospel is one of the best known references, “Go and make disciples of all nations and baptize them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. (Mt28:19). Fourth, St. John presents the detailed teaching of Jesus on the person of the Holy Trinity (Chapters 14 through 18). Jesus says, “I will ask the Father and he will give you another advocate to be with you always, the Spirit of truth (Jn14:16-17). Finally St. Paul refers to the Trinity in his letters. His best known reference is his famous blessing to the Corinthian community in his 2nd letter. “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.”(2Cor13:13). This is the greeting the priest uses it to greet the gathering in the beginning of every mass.

The Holy Mass is centered on the faith of the Blessed Trinity: As far as I am concerned, the whole mass is centered on the faith of the Holy Trinity. The beginning greeting and ending blessing of the mass are in the name of the Holy Trinity. Moreover, the ‘Hymn Gloria’ is our praise to the Holy Trinity. Besides, the creed we recite is based on doctrine of Trinitarian faith. The doxology at the end of the Eucharistic prayer, “through him, with him, and in him” is again our praise to the Trinity. Hence the holy mass is our praise and thanksgiving to the Trinitarian God.

Importance of the Holy Trinity in Christian Life: All prayers in the church begin in the name of the Holy Trinity and end glorifying the Trinity. All sacraments are administered in the name of the Holy Trinity. For example, we are baptized, confirmed and anointed in the name of Holy Trinity. We bless ourselves and the priest blesses us in the name of the Holy Trinity. So the Holy Trinity has lots of significance in our Christian life.

The function of Trinity: God the Father sent God the Son into the world for the plan of salvation; having accomplished the salvation of the world, God the Son ascended to God the Father, and sent God the Holy Spirit to guide us spiritually. The function of God the Father is known as the creator, the function of God the Son is known as the redeemer, and the function of God the Holy Spirit is known as the sanctifier and counselor. Basically one God functions as three persons.

Therefore, the feast of the most holy trinity invites us all to practice the Trinitarian relationship of love, unity, and friendship or fellowship in our family relationship between father, mother, and children because by baptism we became children of God and members of God’s Trinitarian family. Let us conclude with our basic prayer to the Holy Trinity: “Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. **As it was in** the beginning is now, and ever shall be, world without end, Amen.”
