Honoring your father is the secret of your long life

Happy Father's Day!

A young man was getting ready to graduate from college. For many months he had admired a beautiful sports car in a dealer's showroom, and knowing his father could well afford it, he told him that was all he wanted. On the morning of his graduation, his father called him into his private study room and told him how proud he was to have such a fine son, and how much he loved him. He handed his son a beautifully wrapped gift box. But, his son was disappointed when opened the box and found a Bible. Therefore, angrily, he raised his voice at his father and said, "With all your money, you give me a Bible?" and went out of the house, leaving the Bible. Many years passed and the young man was very successful in business. He had a beautiful home and wonderful family, but realized his father was very old, and thought perhaps he should go to him. He had not seen him since that graduation day. Before he could make arrangements, he received a telegram telling him his father had passed away, and willed all of his possessions to his son. He needed to come home immediately and take care of things. When he arrived at his father's house, with all his sadness, he began to search for his father's important papers and saw the Bible which he had left years ago. With tears, when he opened the Bible and began to turn the pages, a car key dropped from an envelope taped behind the Bible. It had a tag with the dealer's name, the same dealer who had the sports car he had desired. On the tag was the date of his graduation, and the words ... PAID IN FULL.

How many times we miss God's blessings because they are not packaged as we expected? How many times we miss God's blessings because they are not packaged as we expected? As Father's Day was born in memory and gratitude by a daughter who thought that her father and all good fathers should be honored with a special day, let us pray to God the Father to bless our fathers and spiritual fathers in abundance today.

Do you know the secret of long life? Let me explain to you about it. Biblically speaking, according to the Book of Sirach, first, he, who honors his father, atones for his sins. Lord will hear his prayers and his own children will make him happy. Second, "if you honor your father in your word and deed, his blessings may come upon you because father's blessing gives a family firm roots." Therefore, God says, "My son, take care of your father when he is old, give him no cause for worry as long as he lives. Be sympathetic even if his mind fails him. Don't look down upon him just because you are strong and healthy." Third, the Lord will not forget your kindness you show to your father because "it will help you to make up for your sins; your sins will melt away like frost in warm sunshine." Therefore only a blasphemer is he who despises his father. Finally, he who reveres his father will live a long life (Sirach 3: 1-16) which St Paul also quotes in his letter to Ephesians 6:2, "If you honor your father, you will have a long life (Eph 6:2)." Hence, honoring your father is the secret of your long life.

Let us pray for all fathers today that they may be more faithful to their fatherly duties in the family, especially in showing a good role model that their children can always look up to. Let us pray for our own fathers, and last but not least, let us also pray for the priests who are our spiritual fathers on the Father's day and ever be grateful to them.
