### **What is a Christ's disciple supposed to do?**

#### **Why did Jesus choose his disciples?**

1. To be with him – to be to be with him in prayer;
2. To spread the good news of Jesus – by our simple and humble evangelization in our life;
3. To drive out the evil spirits – to drive out our personal sins and taking effort to drive out social sins in the society.

#### **An author identifies ten qualities of a Christ's disciple. A Disciple...**

1. Is passionately committed to Jesus – zealously putting him first in every area of life.
2. Is sensitive & submitted to the Holy Spirit – maintaining a posture of openness and humility to the Spirit's inner promptings.
3. Evaluates life according to biblical standards – knows the Word and applies it effectively to all aspects of life; is not distracted by the world's standards.
4. Lives morally pure – recognizes their body as the temple of the Holy Spirit, and through his empowerment walks in holiness of thought, word and deed as an act of genuine worship.
5. Is dedicated to a healthy family – flowing first out of a love relationship with God, they actively seek to promote strong loving relationships in the home.
6. Embraces cultural reconciliation – sees those of other cultures as equals, values the enriching nature of their cultural differences, intentionally pursues relationships with them, seeks to overcome relational barriers through love, humility and honest dialog.
7. Engages in biblical community – prioritizes deepening relationships with others in the context of a small group for the purpose of furthering spiritual and emotional growth and community impact.
8. Is committed to living a missional life – understands that they were created with a God-given purpose and intentionally pursues discovering and fulfilling it.
9. Is evangelistically bold – has been so impacted by God that they can't help but share him with others – through words and deeds - engaging people where they're at through relationship.
10. Is socially purposeful & responsible – proactively engaging the world around us; being the tangible compassion and love of Christ to the world.

#### **What are we supposed to do? St. Paul mentions that, if we believe that we are redeemed by Christ, then, we are supposed to do three things as disciples in his letter to Ephesians:**

1. Jesus wants us to know that we exist for the praise of his glory;
2. Jesus wants us to do everything according to his will; and
3. Jesus wants us to be holy and without blemish before him.
