Divine Mercy Sunday "His mercy endures forever!"

Background: During the course of Jesus' revelations to Saint Faustina on the Divine Mercy He asked on numerous occasions that a feast day be dedicated to the Divine Mercy and that this feast be celebrated on the Sunday after Easter. The liturgical texts of that day, the 2nd Sunday of Easter, concern the institution of the Sacrament of Penance, the Tribunal of the Divine Mercy, and are thus already suited to the request of Our Lord. Pope John Paul II on the occasion of the canonization of Sr. Faustina on 30 April 2000 stated that "throughout the world the Second Sunday of Easter will receive the name Divine Mercy Sunday."

Importance: The Feast includes the solemn, public veneration of the Image of Divine Mercy by the Church, as well as personal acts of veneration and mercy. The great promise for the individual soul is that a devotional act of sacramental penance and Communion will obtain for that soul the plenitude of the divine mercy on the Feast.

The message of Divine Mercy: ABC: **A** – Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world. **B** – Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others just as He does to us. **C** – Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive. So, as His mercy is greater than our sins, let us call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others.

Year of Mercy Reflection by Pope Francis for April 3rd

The Good Thief: The thief who went astray in his life, but now repents, clings to the crucified Jesus and begs him: "Remember me, when you come into your kingdom" (Lk 23:42). Jesus promises him: "Today you will be with me in paradise" (v. 43), in his kingdom. Jesus speaks only a word of forgiveness, not of condemnation; whenever anyone finds the courage to ask for this forgiveness, the Lord does not let such a petition go unheard.

Reflection: Read the account of the good thief in Luke 23: 29-43 and put yourself in the story as the thief. In our relationship with God, it is important to recognize that we are sinners before the Lord, but sinners who are loved and forgiven, not condemned. What does Jesus say to you as you picture the scene?

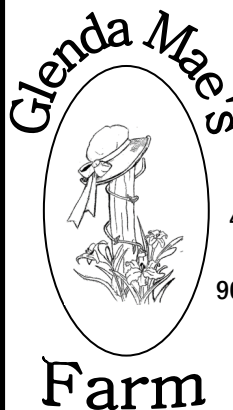
