## Pastor's Desk



### 11 Sunday –C God's Mercy and forgiveness in our life

**Is God's forgiveness is unconditional?** Yes and No. One would argue based on Matthew's gospel 18. On the one hand, I would like to say, yes, it is unconditional: when Peter asks Jesus, Lord, if another person sins against me, how often should I forgive? as many as seven times?" Jesus told him, "Not seven times, but, I tell you, seventy seven times;" but then, Jesus responds that there should be no limit to the number of times; we must be ready to forgive those who wrong us seventy seven times, just as there is no limit to the father's forgiveness of us. On the other hand, I would like to say No, God's forgiveness is sometimes conditional: In the same chapter, in the parable of the unforgiving servant, as the king in the parable withdraws his forgiveness of his servant because of the servant's failure to forgive another, so will God withdraw his forgiveness of the unforgiving and merciless among us. So, God's forgiveness is not entirely unconditional; if we do not share it, we will lose it.

**God's forgiveness makes us humble:** in 2 Samuel 12, King David had committed adultery with a woman named Bathsheba, then had her husband killed so he could marry her, when prophet Nathan warned him, King David did not justify his action or use his royal power to silence the prophet, but rather, admitted his fault and asked forgiveness, he said, I have sinned against the Lord." Because the king repented, Nathan said to David, "The Lord has forgiven your sin, you shall not die." Just like King David was so humble to ask forgiveness of the Lord, let us be humble to seek forgiveness of the Lord and one another.

**God's forgiveness makes us happy:** Psalm 32 says, "when we confess our faults to the Lord, he takes away the guilt of our sin; happy the man to whom the Lord imputes not guilt; happy is the one whose fault is taken away. Just as God forgiveness makes us happy, in forgiveness, one who grants forgiveness and one who receives happiness become ultimately happy.

**God's forgiveness makes us strong:** In Luke 7, when a sinful woman expressed sincere repentance and asked for the forgiveness of her grave sins in public. Jesus forgave the woman, "your sins are forgiven; your faith has saved you; go in peace." Once Jesus forgives her sins, her relationship life with Jesus, with others, in the community, is renewed; indeed, her forgiveness of sins by Jesus made her strong in relationship with one another. In the year of mercy, mercy demand us to forgive one another a little more, even though God's forgiveness humbles us, it makes us happy and strong in our relationship with God and with one another.

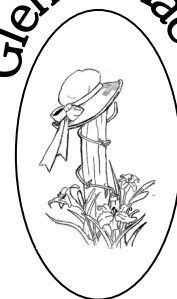
