God blesses responsible fathers of the family

Studies show that children with fathers present have a lower rate of delinquency, drug and alcohol use, teen pregnancy, and so on, than those with absent fathers. The father's presence is also a significant positive factor in children's getting a college education, finding a satisfying job, and making a lasting marriage. Single mothers tell us that it is terribly difficult to teach their children about the meaning of God the Father, who seems so impersonal because their natural fathers have abandoned their children.

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, a father with his wife *cooperates with God the Creator* in bringing a new human life and in educating their children (#2367). In the bible, God says, "I will be a father to you and you shall be sons and daughters to me" (2 Cor 16:18). One of the commandments of God is, "Honor your father and mother (Ex 20:12; Mt 19:19). St. Paul advises that it is the role of a father to bring up their children with faith education in the Lord" (Eph 6: 1-4). Book of Sirach 3: 1-16, says that "father's honor is a man's glory; he who honors his father receives lots of blessings: he atones for his sins; receives long life; gladdened by his own children; if they take care of their fathers, their kindness will be forgotten and God will bless them."

So, I encourage all the fathers in our parish to thank God for the gift of fatherhood and to be always a role model for their children and to be more responsible in bringing up their children in Catholic faith. I advise everyone to love and respect our own fathers and spiritual fathers and pray for them today in a special manner and receive God's blessings. I wish you all a very blessed Father's Day to all the fathers in our parish!

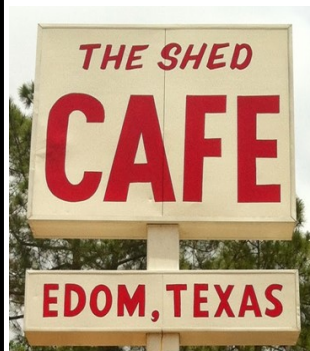

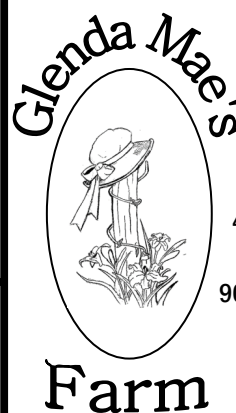
