Helping our Children Have Faith – Religious Instruction at St. Boniface for 2016-2017.

Our Catholic faith is vitally important to us and our children's future. We need to provide God's standards, laws, and principles which can steer us through the secular challenges and moral dangers of our world today. It will help us and our children to be pleasing to God and thereby to receive his blessings.

We have a wonderful set of bilingual materials. They are carefully crafted for each age level. They wonderfully bilingual with identical pages in English and Spanish facing each other which will enable all families, regardless of the language situation in the home, to work together enabling greater learning of both parents and children. It has wonderful teacher resources making it easy to teach.

The first segment is "presacramental" with separate books for each age, 5, 6, and 7 years of age. The "sacramental" segment has separate books for 8, 9, and 10 year olds. The first covers Baptism and Reconciliation, the second covers Confirmation, and the last covers the Holy Eucharist. Confirmation will normally occur at about nine years of age. First Eucharist will occur at about ten years of age. We will have additional classes or opportunities for growing our faith for both Junior High and Senior High youth.

Tenemos un maravilloso conjunto de materiales bilingües. Estos materiales están cuidadosamente elaborados para cada nivel de edad. Son bilingüe con páginas idénticas en Inglés y en español frente a la otra que permitirá a todas las familias, independientemente de la situación de la lengua en el hogar, para trabajar juntos permitiendo un mayor aprendizaje de ambos padres y niños. Tiene recursos maravillosos para maestros por lo que es fácil de enseñar.

El primer segmento es "presacramental" con los libros separados para cada edad, 5, 6, y 7 años. El segmento "sacramental" tiene libros separados para niños de 8, 9 y 10 años. El primero cubre el bautismo y la Reconciliación, la segunda trata de la confirmación, y el último cubre la Santa Eucaristía. La confirmación se produce normalmente cerca de nueve años de edad. Primera Eucaristía tendrá lugar en unos diez años de edad. Tendremos clases o oportunidades adicionales para el crecimiento de nuestra fe, tanto para Secundaria y Superior de la juventud.
